

Senior Class 2018- Information on Senior Portraits/Yearbook Requirements

1. Senior Composite Picture- To be included on the composite picture of the senior class that will hang in the school hall, you must have your picture taken by Bruckner's School Photography.

- These pictures will be taken during morning school hours on **Tuesday, August 15, 2017**.
- **Due that day is a \$35 sitting fee** that includes 8 poses in formal attire (drape or tux provided by Bruckner's) that entitles you to an 8 X 10 composite picture (You will receive this in April.) There are other packages available. You will receive a packet on ordering information

2. Senior Casual Pose-

- The yearbook needs a color, vertical photo (any size) of your casual pose. These photos will be returned within a day. Bruckner's School Photography supplies the formals. If you do not wish to have casual pictures made by a professional photographer, yearbook will take your picture at no charge. Just let us know please.
- **The yearbook's deadline for accepting senior casual photographs is Monday, January 8, 2018.**
- **Yearbook scans the pictures so we can use the proof.** If you have not made an appointment with a photographer yet, please do so immediately. It takes several weeks to book an appointment, several weeks to get the proofs back, more time to make your selections, and even more time to get your finished pictures. Allowing three months is not unreasonable. The photographs can be returned within a day. Please consider making appointments outside of school hours.

3. The 2017-2018 **yearbook orders** will be taken **October 16- November 17, 2017**. The price is \$55.00

4. "Grad Ad"
